

RECYCLING GUIDELINES:

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Plastic bottles: PET #1, HDPE #2, drink bottles, milk jugs, detergent bottles

(An easy way to distinguish “acceptable” plastic is if it has a discernible “neck”.

If the container does not have a “neck”, like a yogurt or margarine container, it is not recyclable.)

ONP: newspapers and inserts

Magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper

OCC: brown cardboard boxes, brown paper bags

Metal: aluminum cans, steel/tin cans,

Glass bottles

Telephone books

Cereal boxes.

ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE:

Plastic bags including Food Lion, Dollar General Store, etc. as well as Ziplock bags

Any Styrofoam including packaging materials and egg cartons

Food containers such as pizza boxes and plastic peanut butter jars

Containers with a waxy covering like milk or orange juice containers

Automobile products

Hazardous materials

Yard waste

Plastic toys or flower pots

Clear plastic food containers like salad trays

Any other items not listed above as acceptable
